The Gift Aid Scheme enables us to claim back any tax already paid on a gift of money, no matter how large or small. Subject to a few rules, you can give Practical Action a sum of money, either as a one-off gift or as part of a regular payment, and we can reclaim the tax.

Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, we get an extra 25 pence from HM Revenue & Customs. This means that £10 can be turned into £12.50 as long as donations are made through Gift Aid. Imagine what a difference that could make and it doesn't cost you a thing. The Government will pay to the charity an additional 3p on every £1 you give between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011. This transitional relief for the charity does not affect your personal tax position.

- Your declaration covers any donation you are kind enough to make to us in the future. Therefore please notify us if you change your name or address
- You can cancel this declaration at any time by letting us know in writing. You may need to do this if your tax status changes
- If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return
- In order for the scheme to apply, you must pay an amount of income and/or capital gains tax for each tax year (6 April one year to 5 April the next) that is at least equal to the amount of tax that the charity will reclaim in your gifts for that tax year (currently 25p in each £1 you give).
- The tax reclaimed will be used to fund the whole of Practical Action's work
